



5 ~ Ormond/ Odabashian Olivia ~ O372



Camelot's Jumping Jack was dethroned by a queen and put into early retirement. She has consistently beaten her sire as well as my other herd bucks. She is built like a tank and has a really nice buck head. Curiosity loves to show off very naturally. I still remember a judge being puzzled and shaking his head, after picking her Best In Show, since she is a doe, but looks like a buck!

I have tried to put her into my breeding program, but she seems to think she wants to show! She has had two live litters but refuses to raise them. She seems so "into" showing; she would rather be showing and wants no part in raising little ones. She is re-bred again and I am keeping my fingers crossed that she gives up on being a starlet or queen.

She placed 9th broken junior doe at Holland Lop Nationals 2014, and won Best in Show, the day after show Tri County RBA. Curiosity came in a close 2nd at the 2014 ARBA Convention, even after having a few litters. She has 21 Grand Champion Legs 3 Best in Show wins, 2 Best 4-Class, 10 BOB's, and 8 BOS wins to her name.


It is an honor to have the 8th place Top Lop for 2014. Congrats to all the other winners!
