Hans Albrecht was one of the first importers and promoters of the Holland Lop. He imported Holland Lops from Germany promoting and showing all over the west coast as well as at conventions and Holland nationals. He was instrumental in helping numerous breeders get their start with Hollands and the Albrecht line is behind many pedigrees. He was known for selling his best and most winning rabbits and sharing his knowledge of the breed with others. He won BOS at the 1989 HLRSC Nationals, and Herdsman of the Year in 1992.



Hans was a quiet man that liked to help behind the scenes, like putting the club booth together for the Portland convention in 1986. He also put up the club booth in Tulsa and took over as Supply chairman that year.

Hans passed away in November 1997 after he learned about this award. Jamie Wardlow's, CJ Caleb, who took Best in Show that year at convention, was the grandson of a buck he had sold Jamie the year before. Hans was ecstatic to hear about her big win! His death was felt club wide. He had sold rabbits and helped so many across the nation.
