Vi and her husband Howell, were two of the first members of the HLRSC. Vi served as club president from 1989-1992 and as Vice President in 1998. She was instrumental in getting the HLRSC incorporated, as well as helped the club achieve non-profit status.

Her first big win was with Lord Phillip who won Best of Breed at both the Tulsa ARBA Convention in 1989, as well as Best of Breed at the Nationals show in Huntington, IN in 1992. She and Howell were Herdsman of the Year for four years, between 1987 and 1990. She hosted the 1984 National Show and spearheaded the 1993 Nationals.

Vi's southern charm and hospitality is legendary. She helped form the Music City Labor Day Show, which became a long weekend event including a barbeque, that drew breeders from all over the east coast.
