Jamie joined the HLRSC in the early 80's and was involved heavily with the club during the 80's and 90's, serving as a director for three terms, and as chairman of Holland Nationals, in Illinois. Jamie worked as a vet tech and helped numerous breeders with their Holland health questions. She also put on an ARBA Convention youth seminar, along with Amy Ginley, to help educate our youth.

Jamie and Randy Shumaker were responsible for coming up with ways for the HLRSC to fund awards for conventions and national shows. Prior to the establishment of the banquet auction, stock auctions, and the convention trio raffle, awards relied totally on donations. These fundraisers allowed the HLRSC to be the first specialty club not to rely on sponsors for awards, plus we were also the first club to give an awards allowance to specialty clubs hosting nationals shows.

Jamie was also a very successful breeder winning numerous awards at the ARBA Convention and Holland Nationals (1 Best of Group at Convention, 6 BOB, 6 BOS, 8 Best Display wins). She also has the honor of winning the first Best in Show with a Holland at an ARBA Convention. CJ's Caleb, who not only won Best in Show at an ARBA Convention, but also won BOB at two separate ARBA Conventions!
