The HLRSC Youth Scholarship Program was established in 2013 to honor the memories of youth members DJ and Ben Swan, who tragically lost their lives in an accident in 2012. Through the generosity of donations and fundraising efforts, we have been able to continue to honor them.

In 2026, long-time member Bob Rohrbaugh passed away after a short illness. For more than 35 years, Bob was a dedicated breeder, mentor, exhibitor, and friend to the Holland Lop community. He believed in encouraging young people, sharing his knowledge, and helping others succeed. Through the generosity of his family and those who donated in his memory, the HLRSC is honored to award a second youth scholarship in Bob's name.

These scholarships recognize youth who demonstrate dedication to the Holland Lop breed, sportsmanship, leadership, community involvement, and a commitment to continuing their education. Continued support from our members and friends will help ensure these scholarships remain available for future youth.

Applicants are eligible to apply during their high school graduation year or following completion of their first year of college.
